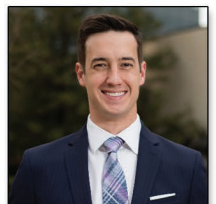
Tony Silva, Certified Professional Ergonomist and Director, Atlas Injury Prevention Solutions
